Tower Removal Information

October 2024

Elecnor Australia (formerly SecureEnergy) has been contracted by Transgrid to deliver part of EnergyConnect with the construction of 700km of new power lines from the SA border to the regional energy hub of Wagga Wagga. The project will connect the electrical grids of New South Wales, South Australia, and Victoria, improving the reliability of our nation's energy supply.

Tower Removal Information

The project team are progressing with the removal of redundant towers on your property. This will include the removal of Asbestos-containing materials (ACMs) which has been identified in the paint on several towers on the line.

The crew will be taking all necessary precautions for the safe removal of the material to ensure the protection of our workers and near neighbours during this activity. This may include the use of protective clothing and equipment. This work is expected to take place from October to 18 November 2024, weather permitting. Our project teams will contact you before commencing the asbestos removal work on your property.
